Engraved Paving Bricks

In Baltimore, there are examples of engraved bricks paving large areas at the foot of Broadway in Fells Point, at the stadium, at the Lutheran Center, and at many other places. We are selling bricks that can be engraved and used to line the walks and courtyard area around Parish Hall. Honor your child, friend, favorite teacher, significant date, or other connection to the congregation or weekday school. Cost is \$125 per brick.

Bricks can be engraved with up to 3 lines (maximum 15 characters per line). Please fill out the form on the back and submit it with your check.
